Usage Instructions and Operating Procedures

- 1. Ensure the plunger is retracted before connecting the impression material.
- 2. Remove the cap from the cartridge and vertically secure it to the cartridge attachment section.
- 3. Attach the mixing tip to the impression material.
- 4. Press the start button to operate the device.
- 5. When replacing the impression material cartridge:
- ① Use the reverse button to fully retract the plunger.
- 2 Remove the impression material cartridge by pulling it upwards.

Cautions

- 1. Use a power cord that meets the specified standards for C-type charging.
- 2. Keep the product away from flammable materials to prevent explosions or fires.
- 3. Protect the product from moisture to prevent electric shock or malfunction,
- 4. Handle the product carefully to avoid damage from drops.
- Do not place or use the product in high temperatures or direct sunlight to prevent internal failure. smoke or fire.
- 6. Do not touch the end of the charger with fingers or conductive objects to avoid overheating or fire hazards.
- 7. Do not frequently insert or remove the product or cable with wet hands to avoid the risk of electric shock,
